Eligibility criteria: Fulltime PhD students not on training grants, but employed by the university.

Procedure: Students meeting the eligibility criteria shall have their tuition and fees paid as part of their compensation for the work they perform for the university. This portion of their compensation shall be referred to as tuition remission. The tuition remission rate will be established annually by the Dean, College of Graduate Studies. The source of payment for the tuition remission will depend upon the activities being performed by the student.

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
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Implementation: This policy shall be phased in as of January 1, 2006 with full implementation by August 1, 2006.
