The South Carolina Clinical & Translational Research (SCTR) Institute's Research Nexus is a specialized, JCAHO-accredited clinical unit that facilitates patient-oriented research. It provides critical resources enabling medical scientists to advance the understanding of human diseases and study therapeutic interventions. The Research Nexus – a 7,000 sq ft facility on the 2nd floor of MUSC's Clinical Sciences Building – houses 6 examination rooms, 6 procedure rooms, 3-chair infusion suite, and a pulmonary function testing suite.

The Research Nexus uses "mobile nursing" to provide research related services in areas best suited to the needs of the study.

Clinical Nursing Services

Studies can be conducted onsite or specially trained personnel are dispatched to the bedside of acutely ill patients throughout the MUSC campus. Chemotherapy & Biotherapy certified research nurses and support staff:


