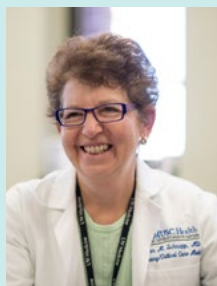


Take My Breath Away: What happens when the lungs get injured
